The Position:

- Opportunities to facilitate group therapy/skills training, e.g., Needle Fears Group, Circle of Security Parenting, CBT for Anxiety, etc.

- For supervised practice psychology members, opportunities for supervision by psychologists with additional competencies in Forensics (youth), Neuropsychology (child) and Health Psychology (child) practice areas. Support in preparation for autonomous registration with the College, including support towards completion of EPPP, JEE, and Oral Examination.
- Opportunities to provide supervision to registering colleagues, Doctoral Associates, residents, or students available.
